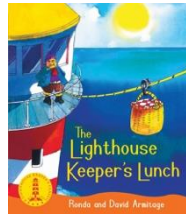


## English

### Non-Fiction:

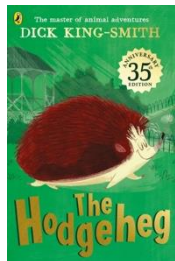
- Writing **recounts** of any wow days or events we experience.

### Poetry:

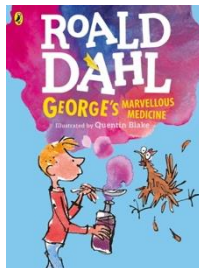
- Writing beach-inspired **shape poems**.

## Mathematics

Across the two terms in mathematics, we will be learning about:

## Topic - Geography

### Geography - our main topic.

Through our topic '**Coastline**' we will learn about the physical and human features of coastal regions across the United Kingdom, including a detailed exploration of the coastal town of Whitby, in Yorkshire.

### History

In term 4 in history, we will learn about jobs in the past, comparing the seaside in the past and present. Finally, we will learn about Captain James Cook.



### Science

#### Term 3 - Uses of Everyday Materials

We will be learning about the **uses of everyday materials** and how materials' properties make them suitable or unsuitable for specific purposes. We will also explore how materials can be changed.



#### Term 4 - Plant Survival.

We will be learning about the **growth of plants** from seeds and bulbs. We will observe the growth of plants first-hand, recording changes over time and identifying what plants need to grow and stay healthy.

## Art

Our art project is called '**Flower Head**'. It teaches children about the visual elements of flowers, including shape, texture, colour, pattern and form. We will also explore various artistic methods, including drawing, printmaking and 3-D forms, using paper and clay.



### Design and technology

We will be completing a project called '**Beach Hut**'. This project teaches children about making and strengthening structures, including different ways of joining materials! We will be making our own beach huts out of wood!



## PSHE

Our Jigsaw PSHE units are '**Dreams and Goals**' and '**Healthy Me**'.

### RE

We will be learning about **Hanukkah** and what it means in **Judaism**. We will also learn about **Losar** and what it means in **Buddhism**.

### PE

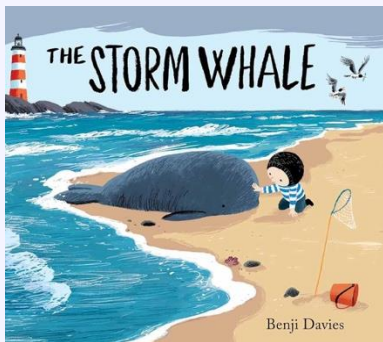
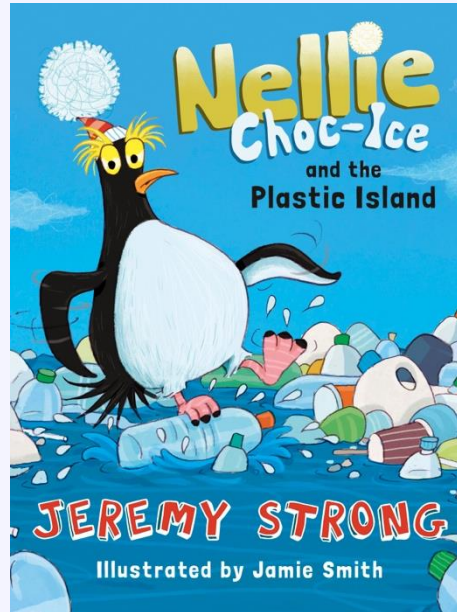
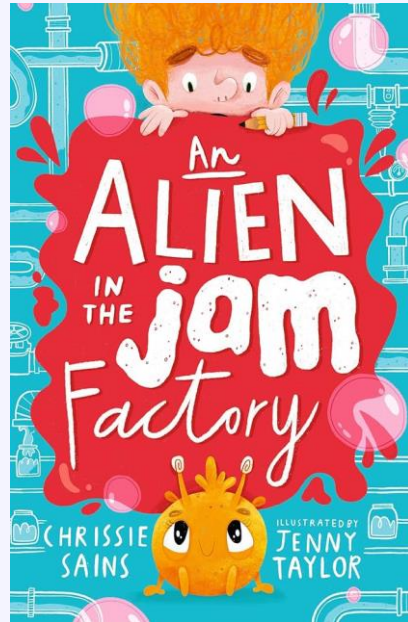
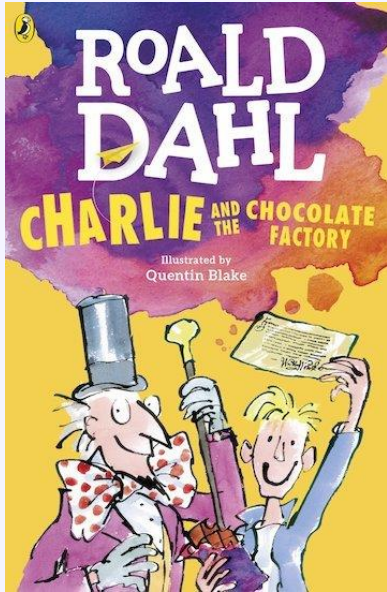
Our two units will be '**Attack, Defend, Shoot**' and '**Hit, Run and Catch**'.
