Science and Maths

Investigate animals' bones, joints and muscles. Explore different skeleton types. Compare the lengths and heights of different prehistoric animals.

Make shadow puppets of prehistoric animals. Find out about which animals lived during the Stone Age.

Research animal diets.

Create your own diary entry as a Stone Age person.

Research and write facts about Cheddar Man.

Write instructions for How To Wash a Woolly Mammoth.

Art & DT

Create a model of a Stone Age settlement or cave. Research Bell Beaker pottery. Make a Stone Age Necklace. Mix up some natural paints using fruits, vegetables or leaves. Create a model of Stonehenge using biscuits. Build a prehistoric shelter. Design some clothes for a Stone Age person.
