The Great Wall

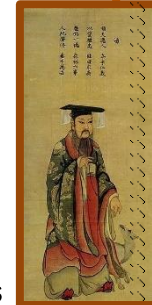
Research where the Great wall of China is and why it was built. Who built it and why is it still important today?
